3.1 Knowledge	<p>Adopted by the United Nations in 2015, the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) are 17 goals with 169 targets that the UN is committed to working towards through the year 2030 with the hope of creating lasting positive change and freedom in the general areas of People, Planet, Prosperity, Peace, and Partnership.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop critical thinking and critical knowledge</li> <li>• Recognize key problems that are directly and indirectly related with the SDGs</li> </ul>
3.2 Comprehension	<p>The purpose of these goals is to create a framework for development programs that will focus on eradicating poverty, hunger, violence, fear, and disease and promoting literacy, equality, human rights, sanitation and hygiene, education, and physical, mental, and social well-being. These goals are meant to build on the Millennium Development Goals and work towards the three key areas the UN identifies for sustainability, which are economic, social, and environmental development.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand the concept of the SDGs</li> <li>• Understand the needs of the world to towards the implementation of the SDGs</li> <li>• Understand the methods and techniques of evaluating the current situation and implementing the SDGs</li> </ul>
3.3 Application	<p>The SDGs are 17 goals with a total of 169 targets among them, most of which are meant to be achieved by 2030. These goals strive to work towards sustainable economic, social, and environmental development on a global scale.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apply procedures and techniques for the implementation of the SDGs</li> <li>• Implement a European Union legislative framework</li> </ul>

The courses often provide expertise with NGOs or international organizations working to achieve the SDGs through their work.
