### **Project description**

#### The City Challenge

Regenerating Urban Space to connect People in a Healthy Environment

#### What is our question?

Dundaga manor park is one of few regularly planned parks in Latvia that is located near a medieval castle. It is famous with big and old oak and linden trees that are home for different lichen, moss, fungus, insect, bird and animal species. The goal is to help visitors to learn more about diversity of nature in this park using app *ActionBound*. There are various paths in the park so it is also accessible for people in wheelchairs. The science team wanted to research what is valuable and interesting in Dundaga manor park?.

#### What is the possible answer?

Science team decided to develop Interactive walk in Dundaga manor park, showing the diversity of nature and creating interactive tasks.

#### Our solution

Creating interactive path with app *Action Bound* in Dundaga manor park.

#### Our path

Students, teachers, experts from Dundaga tourism information center and Latvia`s State Forests worked together to realize different activities. Some of them:

- Online event on 28<sup>th</sup> January – 1<sup>st</sup> CC event. Science team introducing with their project and planned activities. Discussing with experts what and how could be done and how experts could get involved.
- From spring till end of school year in May – creating interactive path in Dundaga manor park, selecting objects, developing tasks.
- The path was planned, information and tasks prepared, but had not implemented due to COVID19 pandemic and distant learning. School was not able to finish work and develop the interactive game as well as to organize Open event.
